



Uniform Policy

Rationale:

A Uniform Policy reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community and assists in developing pride in representing the school. The establishment of a Uniform Policy assists in dealing with issues of equality, health and safety and expense. The school uniform should be worn in a respectful manner.

Aims:

- To ensure all students are clearly identifiable when representing Langwarrin Primary School, in and out of the school.
- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To maintain practical clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance a positive image of the school community.

Guidelines for Implementation:

- The Uniform Policy applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- It is expected that students in school uniform continue to represent the school values (even when outside school hours).
- The Langwarrin Primary School Uniform consists of the following options:
(Options are not to be combined)

LPS summer dress supplied by Beleza Red windcheater or red polar fleece jacket White or black socks	Black shorts or black skorts Red polo t/shirt Red windcheater or red polar fleece jacket White or black socks
LPS winter black tunic or skirt supplied by Beleza Red polo t/shirt or red skivvy Red windcheater or red polar fleece jacket White or black socks or black tights	Black pants or full length leggings Red polo t/shirt Red windcheater or red polar fleece jacket White or black socks

- Shoe colour should be primarily white, black or red. Shoes should be fully enclosed.
- A red or black broad brimmed hat must be worn in Term 1 and Term 4 in accordance with the LPS Sun Smart Policy.
- It is preferred that outdoor coats are of school colours, red or black.
- No tights, leggings or track pants to be worn underneath the summer dress.
- No leggings or track pants to be worn underneath the winter tunic or skirt.
- No hoodies, branded sweatshirts or branded track pants.
- Hemlines should be of a reasonable length.
- No denim.
- All uniform items should be in 'good repair'.
- Hair should be of a natural colour.
- Haircuts should be of natural look. No shaved or cut-in wording / logos.
- Nail polish is not permitted.
- Make-up or cosmetics are not permitted.
- Watches are permitted.
- Jewellery is limited to small studs or sleepers in ears only.

- Nose piercings are not acceptable.
- Hair accessories worn should be minimal in white, red or black.
- Year 6 commemorative tops should only be worn by year 6 students in that year
- Arrangements can be made to supply school uniforms via States Schools' Relief for families experiencing economic hardship. Please contact the school office.
- Langwarrin Primary School logoed items should be purchased from Beleza School Uniforms.

NB – uniform items with the old LPS logo are acceptable whilst in good repair.

Evaluation:

This policy will be reviewed annually as part of the school's three-year review cycle.
